She served as chairman of the 1995 U.S. Girls' Junior Championship held at Longmeadow Country Club, where she is a former member of the Board of Governors and where she served as the club's first woman president from 1998-2001. She has served on the Women's Trans National Golf Association Executive Committee and the Women's Golf Association of Massachusetts (WGAM), and is a past president of the Women's Eastern Golf Association.

She played in the inaugural U.S. Women's Mid-Amateur Championship in 1987 and has played in nine USGA Senior Women's Amateurs. In addition, she was the 1999 and 2000 WGAM Senior champion and the 1995 Women's Eastern Senior champion.

Roberta is a dynamic and entertaining speaker. If you have not had the opportunity to hear Roberta speak about her favorite past time... golf, then you are truly in for a treat.

Spring Renewal Season is in Full Swing

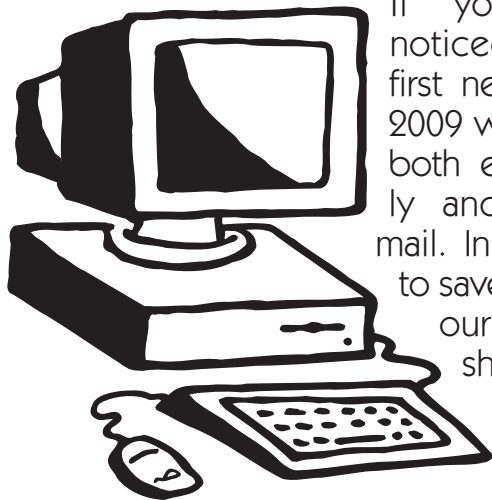
Members who are due to renew in March and April have been sent their renewal notice by mail, as well as in a follow-up email. Renewal is quick and easy:
