COURSE MENTOR: (5 points)

An experienced golfer who partners with new members or coaches new golfers about pace of play, rules and proper etiquette on the golf course. Mentors play at least two times with a new member at their league night or a new player during an EWGA sponsored new golfer lesson.

GRADUATE MENTOR: (5 points)

An experienced golfer who plays two 9-hole scramble rounds with a beginner golfer, at a course of their choice. The beginner golfer must have completed a Beginner's Clinic and is subject to the two-time guest policy of EWGA membership.

A mentee is someone who is making the transition from instruction to playing on a golf course. Being mentored means being paired with an experienced golfer who can guide them around the golf course and answer questions about etiquette and basic rules.
